



The man in the picture was called Jose Lacasa Muñoz, the grandfather of the current generation running the company. He was a hard-working, visionary and pioneering man.

In 1973, after returning with his family from an immigrant journey in Paris (where the father of the current generation was born) full of experiences and hard work, he decided that it was not enough to treasure those memories; he wanted to share them. Thus the first journey was born: a modest bus company that, over time, would weave dreams on wheels.

He didn't just drive buses; he built bridges to new horizons. Along the way, the unexpected became a new direction: from the earthly roads to the open skies. The bus company transformed, like a chrysalis that gives way to a butterfly, into a travel agency. Thus began this odyssey as a family dedicated to the fascinating world of tourism and pilgrimages.

Today, we look back with pride at the path that Pepe Lacasa forged, as his dreams became those of our father, and these are still very much alive in the daily work of the family, more than 50 years later. 

DAYS 1 & 2. FLIGHT USA - KRAKOW

Overnight flight - Arrival in Madrid from the United States - Transfer to the hotel and check-in - **Overnight in Krakow.**

DAY 3. KRAKOW

Visit of Krakow, known as the "Museum of Museums": Wawel Hill, the Gothic Cathedral with its 20 chapels and the sarcophagi of the first Polish kings. We will continue the visit with a walk along Kanonicza Street, stopping near the "Deanery", one of the most beautiful buildings, we will continue through the surroundings of the Archbishop's Palace and the Franciscan Church. Visit of the court of the Jagiellonian University and we will head towards the Old Town: medieval Main Square, the largest in Europe; historic buildings such as the Cloth Hall; the Basilica of Our Lady "Mariacki" and the Town Hall Tower. **Overnight in Krakow**

DAY 4. CRACOVIA - AUSCHWITZ - KALWARIA ZEBRZYDOWSKA

Visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau. Concentration camp, place of martyrdom of St. Edith Stein and St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit of the interior with a local guide, including St. Maximilian's cell and the Martyrdom Museum. Lunch at a local restaurant. Continue to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, the pilgrimage destination of the young Wojtyla with his father, where the famous sanctuary of the Madonna is located, surrounded by a group of picturesque chapels, inserted in the beautiful landscape of the Beskidy. **Overnight in Krakow.**

DAY 5. CRACOVIA - WIELICZKA - WADOWICE

Visit to Wieliczka, an impressive labyrinth of galleries, underground lakes, chambers and chapels dug into the salt rock 700 years ago. Continue to Wadowice. Visit of Wadowice: visit to the museum of Pope John Paul II, and the parish church, and St. Peter's Church, built as a sacrifice after the 1983 attack. **Night in Krakow.**

DAY 6. CRACOVIA - CZESTOCHOWA - CRACOVIA

Visit of Czestochowa, the city where the Jasna Góra Monastery is located with its famous image of the "Black Madonna" visited annually by more than 5 million people, being the most important Marian Monastery in Poland. **Night in Krakow.**

DAY 7. KRAKOW - LAGIEWNIKI - WARSAW

Visit to the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy where St. Faustina lived. Her tomb, relics and the nearby Sanctuary of St. John Paul II are located there. **Overnight in Warsaw.**


DAY 8. VARSOVIA - NIEPOKALANÓW - VARSOVIA

Visit the Church of St. Stanislaus Kostka, where the grave of Fr. Popieluszko, a martyr from the communist era beatified in 2010, is located. Visit the city and its historic centre, the former Ghetto, the Old Town. The Market Square where we will see the Mermaid monument, symbol of Warsaw.

We will continue along the Barbican and the remains of the city walls, with a spectacular view of the Vistula. We will continue on to the Cathedral and Castle Square, one of the oldest in the city, with King Sigismund's Column. In the eastern part of the square stands the wonderful Royal Castle. Departure to Niepokalanow to visit the Sanctuary and convent where St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe resided. **Night in Warsaw.**

DAY 9. WARSAW - AIRPORT OF ORIGIN

After breakfast we will leave for Warsaw airport to take our flight back to the airport of origin. Arrival. **End of our services.**



DAYS 1 & 2. FLIGHT USA - TEL AVIV

Overnight flight - Arrival in Tel Aviv from the United States - Transfer to the hotel and check-in - **Overnight in Tel Aviv**.

DAY 3. TEL AVIV - MT. CARMEL - HAIFA - TIBERIAS

Depart from Tel Aviv and journey north to Mt. Carmel for a visit to the Stella Maris Monastery, followed by a panoramic tour of Haifa. Continue through the scenic Galilee region, arriving in Tiberias for dinner and overnight stay. **Overnight in Tiberias.**

DAY 4. TIBERIAS - CANA - NAZARETH - MT. TABOR - TIBERIAS

Begin in Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle, with an opportunity for couples to renew their wedding vows. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the old market. Then, ascend Mount Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. Return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight stay. **Overnight in Tiberias.**

DAY 5. TEL AVIV - MT. CARMEL - HAIFA - TIBERIAS

Begin at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount. Visit Tabgha, site of the multiplication of loaves and fishes, and the Church of Peter's Primacy. Continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived and began His ministry. Celebrate Mass on a boat on the Sea of Galilee, then travel to Bethlehem. **Overnight in Bethlehem.**

DAY 6. BETHLEHEM - NATIVITY CHURCH - SEPHERD'S FIELD - EIN KAREM

Begin with Mass at Shepherd's Field, then visit the Church of the Nativity, marking Jesus' birthplace. In the afternoon, travel to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and visit the Church of the Visitation, where Mary proclaimed the Magnificat. Return to Bethlehem for dinner. **Overnight in Bethlehem.**

DAY 7. BETHANY - JORDAN RIVER - JERICHO - QUMRAN - DEAD SEA

Begin with a visit to Bethany and the church dedicated to Lazarus. Continue to the Jordan River for a renewal of baptismal vows. Celebrate Mass in Jericho, the world's oldest city, then visit the Mount of Temptation and Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. End the day floating in the Dead Sea before returning to Bethlehem for dinner. and overnight stay.

DAY 8. JERUSALEM: MT. OLIVES & MT. ZION


Explore Jerusalem beginning at the Mount of Olives and the Pater Noster. Walk the Palm Sunday route, visiting Dominus Flevit and the Garden of Gethsemane, with Mass at the Church of All Nations. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, then head to Mount Zion to see the Upper Room and St. Peter in Gallicantu. **Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.**


DAY 9. VIA DOLOROSA


Begin with a meditative walk along the Via Dolorosa, reflecting at each Station of the Cross and celebrating Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit St. Anne's Church, the Ecce Homo, and the Wailing Wall. Enjoy free time in the afternoon before a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Bethlehem.


DAY 10. TEL AVIV AIRPORT - RETURN FLIGHT



ISTANBUL - NICAEA - EPHESUS - VIRGIN MARY'S HOUSE - CAPPADOCIA - THESSALONIKI - METEORA - DELPHI - ATHENS - SARONIC GULF CRUISE

DAY 1 - FLIGHT FROM USA TO ISTANBUL

Meet at the origin airport three hours before departure. Night flight to Istanbul. Suggested reflection: St. Paul, Apostle to the Nations, dedicated his life to evangelizing gentile lands—like those we will soon visit in Turkey and Greece.

DAY 2 - ARRIVAL IN ISTANBUL

Arrival in Istanbul. Transfer to the hotel and panoramic city tour, highlighting the Christian history of ancient Constantinople. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 3 - ISTANBUL - HAGIA SOPHIA AND BOSPHORUS CRUISE

Visit the Spice Bazaar and Hagia Sophia, the iconic Church of Holy Wisdom and symbol of Eastern Christianity. Free time at the Grand Bazaar. Enjoy a Bosphorus cruise with reflection on a faith that crossed continents. Overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 4 - ISTANBUL - NICAEA (IZNIK) - BURSA

Visit Topkapi Palace, then travel to Nicaea (Iznik), site of the First Ecumenical Council in 325 AD, where the Nicene Creed was established. Continue to Bursa. Overnight in Bursa.

DAY 5 - BURSA - THYATIRA - SMYRNA - KUSADASI

Visit Thyatira, one of the Seven Churches of Revelation, and reflect on the call to faithfulness. Continue to Smyrna (Izmir), where St. John encouraged persecuted Christians, and visit the site of St. Polycarp's martyrdom. Proceed to Kusadasi. Overnight in Kusadasi.

DAY 6 - Excursion to Patmos

Day trip to the island of Patmos, one of Christianity's holiest sites, where St. John wrote the Book of Revelation during his exile. Return to Kusadasi. Overnight in Kusadasi.

DAY 7 - EPHESUS AND THE VIRGIN MARY'S HOUSE

Visit the ancient city of Ephesus, an important site for St. Paul's preaching, and the traditional House of the Virgin Mary, believed to be her final home. Continue to Pamukkale. Overnight in Pamukkale.

DAY 8 - PAMUKKALE AND KONYA (ICONIUM)

Explore Pamukkale's unique white terraces formed by thermal waters. Travel to Konya, ancient Iconium, visited by St. Paul. Overnight in Konya.

DAY 9 - KONYA TO CAPPADOCIA

Depart for Cappadocia and begin exploring this early Christian refuge with its rock-hewn churches and valleys. Overnight in Cappadocia.

DAY 10 - CAPPADOCIA AND FLIGHT TO ISTANBUL

Optional early morning hot air balloon ride (weather permitting). Visit the Valley of the Monks, Göreme, and early Christian cave dwellings. Evening flight to Istanbul. Overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 11 - FLIGHT TO THESSALONIKI AND VISIT TO PHILIPPI

Morning flight to Thessaloniki, then travel to Philippi, where St. Paul baptized Lydia, the first Christian convert in Europe. Reflection on evangelization. Return to Thessaloniki. Overnight in Thessaloniki.

DAY 12 - THESSALONIKI - VERIA - METEORA - KALAMBAKA

Visit Veria (ancient Berea), where Paul was welcomed and the Bereans were praised for studying the Scriptures. Continue to the Meteora monasteries, preserving Christian faith in hard times. Overnight in Trikala.

DAY 13 - KALAMBAKA - DELPHI - ATHENS

Travel to Delphi, ancient center of pagan prophecy, and reflect on the contrast with Christian faith. Continue to Athens. Overnight in Athens.

DAY 14 - ATHENS AND THE AREOPAGUS

Visit the Acropolis and Areopagus, where Paul preached about the "Unknown God." Free time in the Plaka district. Overnight in Athens.

DAY 15 - SARONIC GULF CRUISE

Full-day cruise to the islands of Hydra, Poros, and Aegina, with optional visit to the Temple of Aphaia. Reflection on God's creation. Return to Athens. Overnight in Athens.

DAY 16 - RETURN FLIGHT

Breakfast and transfer to the airport for return flight. End of services.



BARCELONA - MADRID - AVILA - SALAMANCA - FATIMA - COIMBRA BRAGA - SANTIAGO - LUGO - OVIEDO - COVADONGA - SANTANDER LOYOLA - LOURDES - ZARAGOZA - ALCALA DE HENARES

DAYS 1 AND 2. PLACE OF ORIGIN - MADRID

Flight to Madrid. Overnight flight. Arrival, transfer to hotel and check-in. **Overnight in Madrid.**

DAY 3: MADRID

Visit to the Basilica of San Francisco el Grande. Famous for its great dome, the 3rd largest in Europe after that of St. Peter's in Rome and that of Santa Maria del Fiore in Florence. We will continue with the Almudena Cathedral. Consecrated in 1993 by John Paul II, and where the Virgin of Almudena, patron saint of Madrid, is venerated. Finally, we will visit the Monastery of El Escorial. Built in the 16th century by order of Philip II to bury his father, Charles V. **Night in Madrid.**

DAY 4: MADRID - AVILA - SALAMANCA

Transfer to Ávila, where we will visit the Basilica of San Vicente, the Walls of Ávila and the Cathedral of Ávila. After our visits, we will continue our way to Salamanca. **Night in Salamanca.**

DAY 5: SALAMANCA

We will visit the Cathedral, the Church of the Clerecía where inside is the Tower of the Clerecía, which offers one of the most impressive views. The University of Salamanca is one of the oldest and most prestigious educational institutions in Spain, founded in 1218, the Patio de las Escuelas, where the famous frog sculpture is located, **Night in Salamanca.**

DAY 6: SALAMANCA - FATIMA

Transfer to Fatima. In the afternoon, we will be able to participate in all the activities . **Overnight in Fatima.**

DAY 7: FATIMA

Day in Fatima. We will have the opportunity to do the Via Crucis, which will take us to Aljustrel, the nearby village where the shepherds of the apraciones were born and lived. There we will be able to visit the Houses of the Shepherds, and learn a little more about their life. **Night in Fatima.**

DAY 8: FATIMA - COIMBRA - BRAGA

Transfer to Coimbra, we will visit the famous Joanina Library and the historic center. Transfer to Braga. **Overnight in Braga.**

DAY 9: BRAGA

We will visit the Sanctuary of Bom Jesus do Monte, the Cathedral, known as the Sé de Braga and the historic center of the city. **Overnight in Braga.**

DAY 10: BRAGA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Transfer to Santiago where we will visit the Cathedral, the Plaza del Obradoiro, the Raxoi Palace and the Hostal de los Reyes Católicos, the Monastery of San Martín Pinario, the old town of the city. **Night in Santiago**

DAY 11. SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Visit to the Convent of San Francisco de Asís. A highlight is its impressive church. It is also a place of pilgrimage for devotees of St. Francis of Assisi. **Overnight in Santiago.**

DAY 12. SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - LUGO - OVIEDO

Transfer to Lugo, where we will visit the Roman Wall and the Cathedral. In the afternoon, we will head towards Oviedo, the capital of Asturias. **Night in Asturias.**

DAY 13. OVIEDO - COVADONGA - SANTANDER

Visit of the centre of Oviedo and the Cathedral. Transfer to Covadonga, where we can find the Basilica of Santa María de Covadonga, the patron saint of Asturias. **Night in Santander.**

DAY 14. SANTANDER - LOYOLA - LOURDES

Transfer to Loyola, where we will visit the Sanctuary and Basilica. You can also visit the Museum of St. Ignatius and enjoy panoramic views of the surroundings. We will continue our journey to Lourdes. **Overnight in Lourdes.**

DAY 15. LOURDES

Transfer to Lourdes, one of the most important pilgrimage sites in the world We will be able to participate in the Torchlight Procession, **Night in Lourdes**

DAY 16. LOURDES - ZARAGOZA

Transfer to Zaragoza, crossing the Pyrenees. We will visit the Basilica del Pilar, the historic center and the Cathedral of the Savior. **Night in Zaragoza.**

DAY 17. ZARAGOZA - ALCALÁ DE HENARES - MADRID - PLACE OF ORIGIN

Transfer to Alcalá de Henares to visit this important city. We could visit the Birthplace of Cervantes, the Monastery of San Bernardo, the Convent of the Poor Clares and the Church of San Pedro and San Pablo. The Cathedral and the Plaza de Cervantes, transfer to the airport. Flight to our place of origin. Arrival and **end of our services.**



DAYS 1 AND 2. PLACE OF ORIGIN - BARCELONA

Flight to Madrid from our place of origin. Overnight flight. Arrival, transfer to the hotel and check-in. Welcome dinner and free time to rest. **Overnight in Barcelona.**

DAY 3. BARCELONA

Breakfast and departure to Sagrada Familia, Antoni Gaudí's unfinished masterpiece. Next, we will visit Park Güell, full of colorful structures and panoramic views of the city. DAY 4. BARCELONA - MONTSERRAT - LOURDES




